

# COOKIE POLICY

## 1. General Provisions

- 1.1. SIA “Regulatīvās Tehnoloģijas”, unified registration No. 40203311340, legal address: Elizabetes street 14 – 3, Riga, LV-1010, Email address: [help@aml.plus](mailto:help@aml.plus) ( hereinafter referred to as “the Company” or “we” as appropriate) uses cookies on the websites <https://aml.plus/> and <https://a.aml.plus/> (hereinafter referred to as “the Website”).
- 1.2. This Cookie Policy has been prepared to provide Website visitors with information about the cookies used on the Website, the purposes of their use, and the procedures involved.

## 2. What is a cookie?

- 2.1. A cookie is a small text file that is downloaded and stored on your computer or other device (such as a smartphone or tablet) and saved in your web browser during your visit to the respective website. On each subsequent visit, cookies are sent back to the originating website or to another website that recognizes these cookies. Cookies act as a memory for a specific website, allowing that website to recognize your computer or other device on subsequent visits, including remembering your settings (such as language preferences) or making the website easier to use. Cookies have various purposes and lifespans.

## 3. Purpose and legal basis for the use of cookies

- 3.1. The Website uses cookies to ensure the Website’s functionality and ease of use, to collect visitor statistics and information on how visitors use the Website, to tailor the Website’s operation to visitors’ needs, remember visitors’ cookie preferences, and provide visitors with personalized information about the Company’s services.
- 3.2. Essential cookies are enabled by default. For other cookies used on the Website, the Company requires your consent. By giving your consent in the cookie banner that appears when you visit the Website, you choose whether to allow the use of specific categories of cookies.

## 4. Types/Categories of Cookies and Their Use

- 4.1. Cookies can be divided into several types/categories.
- 4.2. Depending on the duration for which a cookie remains active on the end device, cookies can be classified as:
  - 4.2.1. “session cookies”: these cookies are intended for collecting and storing data while the visitor is accessing the Website. Session cookies will exist only during the browser session, after which they will be deleted. Each browser session begins when you open a browser window and ends when you close it;
  - 4.2.2. “persistent cookies”: these cookies are not deleted when the browser window is closed and are stored on the visitor’s device for a specific period of time after the end of the browsing session on the Website. These cookies allow us to remember your settings or actions on the Website and use them the next time you visit the Website. During their lifetime, these cookies are activated every time you visit the Website.
- 4.3. Depending on the purpose for which cookies are used, they can be categorized as:
  - 4.3.1. “necessary cookies”: these cookies are essential; they ensure the proper functioning of the Website and its basic features and allow the visitor to access various parts of the Website. Without these cookies, the Website cannot function properly. These cookies are necessary for the Website to function, so they cannot be disabled, and therefore your consent for this category of cookies is not required;
  - 4.3.2. "Preference cookies": These cookies allow the Website to remember information that changes the way the Website works or looks, such as your preferred language or the region you are in. Your consent is required for this category of cookies. If you opt out of these cookies, the Site will not be able to remember the information that preference cookies allow it to remember, and your experience on the Site will be less convenient, though the Site will still function;
  - 4.3.3. “Statistical cookies”: These cookies allow us to count the number of visits to the Website and track their sources so that we can measure and improve the Website’s performance. These cookies help us understand which pages are most popular and which are used least frequently, as well as how visitors navigate the Website. For this category of cookies, requires your consent. If you opt out of these

cookies, your visit will not be included in our statistics, but this will not restrict your activity on the Website;

4.3.4. “Marketing cookies”: These cookies are used to identify the content you prefer on the Website and provide you with the most relevant information about our services, improve the personalization of our content, and enhance your experience on the Website. These cookies may be used for our advertising campaigns on third-party websites. Your consent is required for this category of cookies. If you consent to the use of these cookies, we may also receive information about our partners’ websites where you have interacted with our ads. If you opt out of these cookies, you will be shown general and less personalized ads.

4.4.1. Essential cookies:

4.4.2. Preference cookies:

Name	Service provider	Duration	Purpose
lidc	LinkedIn	1 day	This cookie ensures effective load balancing, session stability, and security across all LinkedIn services.
i18n-f	a.aml.plus	persistent	This cookie is used for internationalization (i18n) and to store language preferences, ensuring that the Website displays content in the correct language based on the visitor’s settings or location.
language	a.aml.plus	persistent	Determining the visitor's preferred language. Allows the website to use the visitor's preferred language.
user-language	a.aml.plus	persistent	This cookie improves usability by saving and maintaining the visitor's preferred language settings across browsing sessions.
trp_language	aml.plus	30 days	Determines the visitor's preferred language. Allows the Site to set the preferred language when the visitor returns.

4.4.3. Statistics cookies:


Name	Service provider	Duration	Purpose
_hjSession_#	Hotjar	1 day	Collects statistics on a visitor's visits to the website, such as the number of visits, average time spent on the website, and pages viewed.
_hjSessionUser_#	Hotjar	1 year	Collects statistics on visitor visits to the website, such as the number of visits, average time spent on the website, and pages viewed.
hjActiveViewportIds	Hotjar	persistent	This cookie contains an ID string for the current session. It contains non-personal information about which subpages the visitor is viewing—this information is used to optimize the visitor's experience.
hjViewportId	Hotjar	session	stores the visitor's screen size so that image sizes on the website can be adjusted.

4.4.4. Marketing cookies:

Name	Service provider	Duration	Purpose
_fbc	Meta Platforms, Inc.	3 months	A cookie used by Facebook to select ads based on a visitor's behavior and preferences across multiple websites. The cookie contains an encrypted ID that allows Facebook to identify the visitor across different websites.
_fbp	Meta Platforms, Inc.	3 months	A cookie used by Facebook to deliver a range of advertising products, such as real-time bidding from third-party advertisers.
lastExternalReferrer	Meta Platforms, Inc.	persistent	This cookie tracks how a visitor arrived at the Site by recording their last URL.
lastExternalReferrerTime	Meta Platforms, Inc.	persistent	This cookie determines how the visitor reached the Site by recording their last URL address ( ).

multiFbc	Meta Platforms, Inc.	persistent	This cookie is used to track a visitor's interactions across multiple Facebook ads. This tracking helps advertisers analyze visitor engagement and optimize their advertising strategies.
_ga	Google	2 years	This cookie is used to send data to Google Analytics about the visitor's device and behavior. It tracks visitors across different devices and marketing channels.
_ga_#	Google	2 years	This cookie is used to send data to Google Analytics about the visitor's device and behavior. It tracks visitors across different devices and marketing channels.
bcookie	LinkedIn	1 year	LinkedIn uses this cookie for security, browser identification, and tracking visitor behavior for advertising purposes on LinkedIn and partner sites.
amlplus_session	a.aml.plus	3 days	This cookie is responsible for linking the browser to the server session.

### 5. Consent to the use of cookies, withdrawal of consent, and blocking cookies

- 5.1. When you visit the Website, a pop-up window appears informing you that the Website uses cookies, providing information about the cookies used on the Website, and offering a cookie selection bar.
- 5.2. Consent is not required for necessary cookies, as these cookies ensure the basic functions and operation of the Website, and without them the Website cannot function properly. Your consent is required for the use of other cookies.
- 5.3. If you click the "Allow All" button, this means that you have consented to all cookies on the Website and confirm that you have read the information about cookies, their purposes, and the circumstances under which information is shared with third parties.
- 5.4. If you click the "Reject" button, only the necessary cookies will be retained, the use of which does not require your consent. Please note that this choice may affect the functionality of the Website.
- 5.5. You can customize your preferences by selecting the categories of cookies you consent to and clicking the "Save Preferences" button.
- 5.6. You may withdraw your consent to the use of cookies or change which cookies you allow at any time. To withdraw your consent or change your cookie settings, click the  icon on the Website, which will open a window where you can withdraw your consent or change your selected cookie settings.
- 5.7. By clearing your browser's browsing history, you can delete all cookies stored on your device. However, please note that in this case, you may also lose some saved information (such as saved Website settings).
